



Daisy's Cloche adds style and class to My Mountain!



All the Little Details

Yarn

Schachenmayr Bravo Big Color
Super Bulky – 1 skein (200 g/131 yds)
• Violet Mix

Crochet Hook

P/10.00 mm hook or size needed to
obtain gauge.

Notions

Tapestry Needle

Finished Measurements

Circumference = 23" at widest point

Gauge

5 rows / 6 stitches in 4"x4" area of hdc
worked in fl/bl pattern

Skill Level

Confident Beginner/Intermediate

What's My Mountain? It's a little hard to explain, but I'll give it a try... The concept of "My Mountain" started as a promotion in Europe where the Schachenmayr yarn company asked people what gives you that exhilarating feeling, the adrenaline rush like you've just slalomed down a black diamond trail or summited a world class peak. Well, I've never done either of those but there are a few things that make me want to throw my arms in the air and let out a big whoop of joy!

Right now my greatest mountain moments come from creating original crochet designs. The process of going from idea to sketch and watching as it comes to life with the yarn and hook is just awesome. The final thrill comes from putting the whole thing together on paper so I can share it with you.

Using yarn from Wesminster Fiber I designed this 1920's inspired cloche. It's sassy, bold and puts me on top of My Mountain! I hope you enjoy it too!



Daisy's Cloche

The Cloche



Make Magic Circle

Rnd 1: Beg cl, ch1, (cl, ch1) 7 times around. Join with sl st in top of beg ch3. (16 sts)

Rnd 2: Ch3, dc in same st, dc in next st, *(2dc in next st, dc in next st) repeat from * around. Join with sl st in top of beg ch3. (24 sts)

Rnd 3: Ch2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 3 sts, *(2hdc in next st, hdc in next 3 sts) repeat from * around. Join with sl st in top of beg ch2. (30 sts)

Rnd 4: Ch2, *(hdcbl in next st, hdcfl in next st) repeat from * around. Join with sl st in top of beg ch2. (30 sts)

Rnd 5: Ch2, *(hdcfl in next st, hdcbl in next st) repeat from * around. Join with sl st in top of beg

Rnds 6 – 9: Repeat Rnds 4 & 5 twice. (30 sts)

Rnd 10: Ch1, sc in each st around. Join with sl st in first sc. (30 sts)

Rnd 11: Ch1, 2sc in first st, sc in each st around. Join with sl st in first sc. (31 sts)

Rnd 12: Repeat Rnd 11. (32 sts)

Trim: *(sk first st, shell in next, skip 1sc, sl st in next sc) repeat from * around. Join with sl st in first sc. (8 shells)

Fasten off and weave in ends.

Stitches & Notes

Stitches

- Magic Circle
- Basic Stitches:
slip stitch (sl st), chain (ch), single crochet (sc), half-double crochet (hdc), half-double crochet in front loop (hdcfl), half-double crochet in back loop (hdcbl), double crochet (dc), triple crochet (tr)
- beginning cluster (beg cl): ch3, *yo, insert hook in circle, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull through 2 loops on hook, repeat from * once, yo, pull through all 3 loops on hook.
- cluster (cl): *yo, insert hook in circle, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull through 2 loops on hook, repeat from * twice, yo pull through all 4 loops on hook.
- triple crochet 2 together (tr2tog)
- Shell – 5 dc worked in the same stitch

The cloche is worked from the top down and because of the super bulky yarn it's finished in no time!





The Flower



Ch4, join with sl st to form ring.

Rnd 1: ch3, 1 trp in ring (counts a first tr2tog), *(ch3, tr2tog in ring), repeat from * 5 times, ch3. Join with sl st in top of beg ch3. (6 tr2tog, 6 ch3 spaces)

Rnd 2: ch1, (sc, hdc, 3dc, hdc, sc) in each ch3 sp around. Join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off leaving a long tail to sew flower to cloche.

Choose the position on the hat and attach the flower by stitching from the inside of the hat to the back of the flower. Secure at center and the tip of each petal.

The Button & The Band

The Button

Start with a magic circle and work 8sc into the circle. Join with a sl st in the first sc. Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

The Band

Ch26, 3sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch to the end. Work 3sc in the last ch. Pivot the piece around and work 1sc into the bottom of each ch back to the beginning of the piece. Sl st in the first sc. Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Attach the button to the band and the band to the hat. The band should run across the front of the hat just above the shell trim. Secure the band on each end and about every 4 inches working from the inside of the hat to the back of the band. Weave in any loose ends, and enjoy!

Tip

The button, band and flower are all optional, but they really do add the 1920's flair that makes Daisy's Cloche so much fun. Nothing says bold and sassy like a big beautiful flower!
