All the Little Details

Yarn

Peaches & Cream Cotton (Worsted)
White (Yarn A) & Pink (Yarn B)

Crochet Hook

G-6/4.25 mm

Notions

Tapestry Needle

Finished Measurements

Width: 8 inches
Length: 8 inches

Gauge

Using the indicated yarn and hook I
created an 8 inch square.

Skill Level

Confident Beginner



Stitches & Notes

Stitches

- slip stitch (sl st)
- chain (ch)
- skip (sk)
- space (sp)
- single crochet (sc)
- double crochet (dc)
- Invisible Join (optional)

Tips

- Chaining a circle around the skull and attaching it at evenly spaced intervals will create the "center" of your granny square.
- Work the 3dc clusters around (not into) the chain.



The Pattern

Step 1: Complete skull motif using Yarn A and size G hook.

Step 2: Attach Yarn B at the top right corner of the skull.

Step 3: Ch 2 (counts as 1st hdc), ch 6, skip 6sc, hdc in next sc (top left corner of skull);
(ch 6, sk 6 sc, dc in next sc) twice;
ch 6, sk 6 sc, hdc in next sc (bottom left of jaw);
ch 6, sk 6 sc, hdc in next sc (bottom right of jaw);
(ch 6, sk 6 sc, dc in next sc) twice;
ch 6, sk 6 sc, attach with sl st to top of 1st hdc.

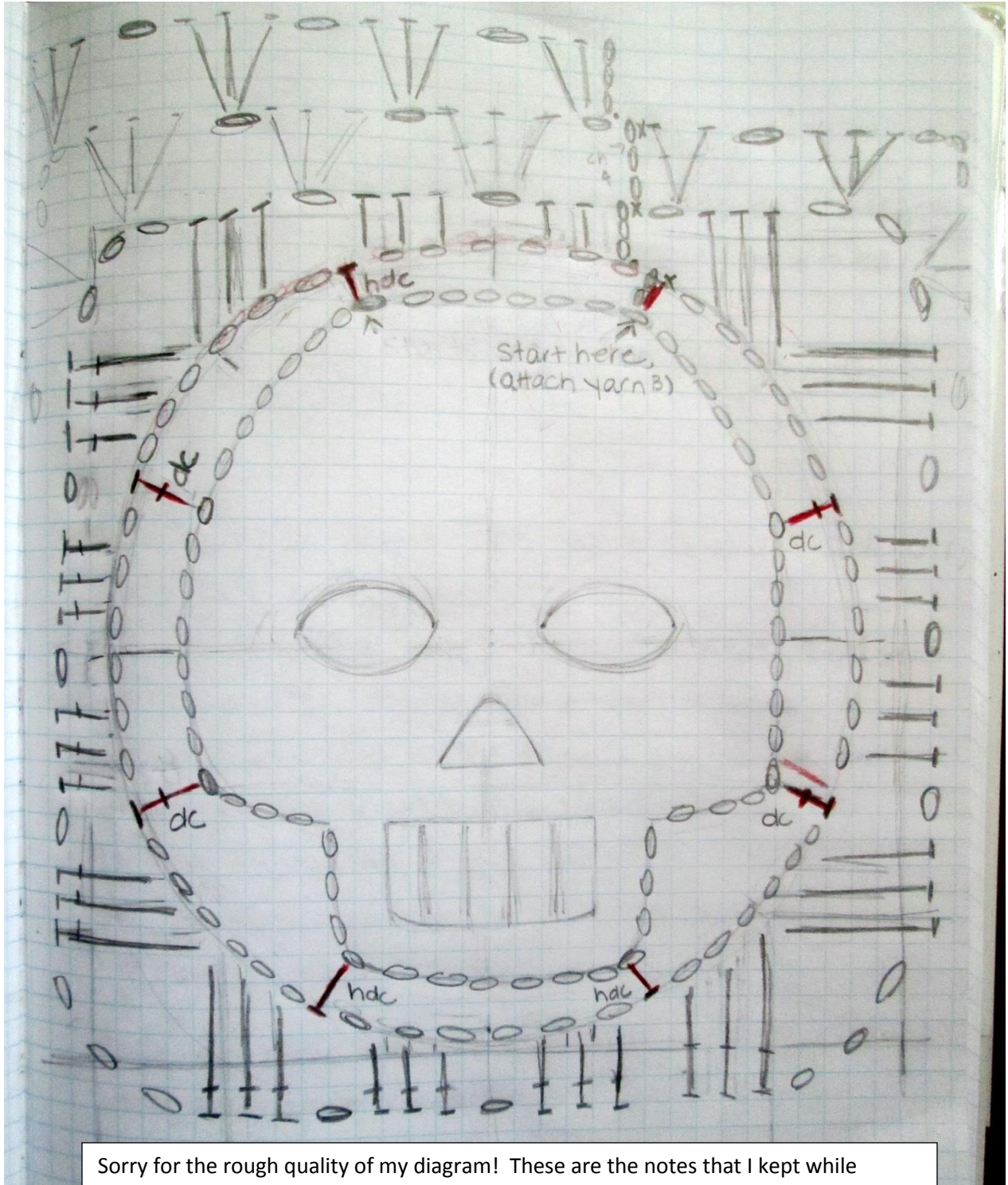
Round 1: (First round of granny square) Remember to work stitches around the chain, not into it.

In first ch 6 space sl st, ch 3 (counts as 1st dc), 2 dc, ch 1, 3 dc, ch 1;
in next ch 6 sp 3dc, ch 3, 3 dc, ch 1 (corner made);
(in next ch 6 sp 3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc, ch 1; in next ch 6 sp, 3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc, ch 1) three times;
attach with sl st to top of 1st dc.

Round 2: Ch 4 (counts as 1st dc, ch 1), in ch 1 sp 3dc, ch 1; in next ch 1 sp 3dc, ch 1;
in ch 3 sp 3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc, ch 1 (corner made);
in next 3 ch 1 sps 3 dc, ch 1**;
repeat from * to ** twice; repeat from * to * once;
in same ch 1 sp as 1st dc, 2 dc;
attach with sl st to top of 1st dc.

Round 3: In first ch 1 space sl st ch 3 (counts as 1st dc), 2 dc, ch 1; in next 2 ch 1 sps 3 dc, ch 1;
in ch 3 sp 3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc, ch 1 (corner made);
in next 4 ch 1 sps 3 dc, ch 1**;
repeat from * to ** twice; repeat from * to * once;
in next ch 1 sp 3 dc, ch 1;
attach with sl st to top of 1st dc. Fasten off.
or attach with invisible join to to of 1st dc. Fasten off.

Weave in the ends, and lightly block to the correct shape. Enjoy!!
